

BEING A RESPONSIBLE PET OWNER IN OUR NEIGHBORHOOD

AERNA is a great place to have pets, but like any urban living situation there are rules to follow that are in place to ensure that our domesticated friends do not create issues with our neighbors. The following is a summary of some of the primary requirements for pet owners in the City of Green Bay:

- Animal waste must be cleaned up when walking your dog on city streets.
- Dogs are not allowed to run loose.
- If an animal is tied up outside, it must be at least 5 feet from sidewalks, streets, alleys, etc.
- All dogs and cats more than 5 months old must be licensed.
- If animals are kept outside, they must have a shelter.
- Barking dogs could be a violation of city ordinances.

City ordinance states that domesticated animals are not allowed in any City park.

Exceptions are as follows:

- Dogs on a visible leash no longer than 7 feet are only allowed to be walked in parks on designated perimeter or pass through walkways or pathways, parking lots serving the walkways or pathways, and designated trails.
- A dog owner/walker and its dog shall not loiter, stop, or stand in the parks or trails.
- If a dog defecates while walking through a park, the dog owner/walker must clean up after the dog and remove such excreta from the park.

SUPER EASY BUFFALO CHICKEN BREASTS

Recipe from Tony, Enjoy!

Ingredients:

4 Skinless boneless chicken breasts
1/2 Cup white wine, beer, broth or just plain water
1 Cup Franks Buffalo wing sauce
1 stick butter



Directions:

Poach the chicken breasts in a covered skillet in the liquid of your choice till they reach 165 degrees F internally. Shred, cube or cut the meat into strips, depending how you wish to eat it. Remove from pan and add the butter and wing sauce. Add the chicken back to the pan, bring to a boil then lower heat to low simmer for 15-20 minutes. Can be put on buns, or eaten just the way it is. Good served with fresh celery sticks and Blue Cheese salad dressing.
