Registration Deadlines and Information:

- Resident teams have priority registration through September 2, 2022. (Resident teams are defined as teams which include at least 51% residents).
- Open Registration begins September 6 - October 10, 2022. (Open registration is defined as teams which include at least 50% or more non-residents).
- Deadline for all teams to register is October 10, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. (Additional teams may be accepted after deadline if openings exist).
- Team Entry Fee is \$443.10 (includes tax) 13-14 league games, 1 practice game.
- Non-resident fee is \$33.76 (includes tax) per non-resident player.
- ***Cancellation: 50% of the total registration amount paid will be refunded for cancellations 2 weeks or prior to the league start date. No refund will be given within 2 weeks of the league start date.***
- All participants must be 18 years or older and not presently enrolled in high school. High school students are not eligible regardless of age.
- Managers may add additional players anytime, even on game day, provided registration information is in our office before 4:00 p.m. (No players can be added after the 8th week of play.) Resident and non-resident players can now be added online, processed in person, by mail, or over the telephone, as long as the non-resident fee accompanies the information. Credit cards are accepted. Please see Rule 2-4 of the Green Bay Athletic League Rules.
- Mail in registration will become valid upon receipt unless there is missing information or the fee has not been paid.
- Managers, be prepared to provide the following information when adding a player to a roster: team name, player name, home address, age, date of birth, and home phone number.
- Players are officially on the roster once all information and fees are received at the Parks, Recreation & Forestry Office.

Entry Information

- By signing the registration form on the reverse side, both manager and player verify the address listed is correct and all applicable fees have been paid. If found in violation, the player will be banned from participating in all department sponsored leagues for one year. Teams will be allowed to continue league play with all contests being forfeited to opponents. Teams will be dropped from the league if they continue to use ineligible players or if they make a mockery of their remaining games. Managers are required to verify player's correct name and address.
- Minimum of 7 players per roster.
- Non-resident fees must be paid at the time of registration.
- Receiving a registration form does not guarantee a spot in the league.

- The league or sponsor will not be responsible for the expenses incurred due to the injury of any player.
- Player addresses listed below are correct and if they are a non-resident, all appropriate fees will be paid. *Falsification of a player's address will result in that participant being banned from all Parks, Recreation & Forestry Department activities for one year.* Teams will be dropped from the league if they continue to use ineligible players or if they make a mockery of their remaining games.
- Players must be 18 years of age or over. High school students must be 18 years old and graduating at the end of the current spring semester. College varsity or professional players are NOT eligible.
- A player will not play on more than one adult team competing in the basketball leagues sponsored by the City of Green Bay on the same evening.
- Players will check all equipment, including uniforms that belong to the sponsor or manager with the sponsor or team manager at the end of the season and understand that if they fail to do so, they will be ineligible to play in any of the City-sponsored sports programs.
- Any team or individuals on a team whose determined ability shows unequal classification may be required to move up or down to the appropriate league as approved by the Administrative Committee.
- Players will pay all expenses of repairing or replacing any publicly owned property that they are responsible for damaging.

ALL PLAYER INFORMATION MUST BE COMPLETED BEFORE TEAM CAN BE REGISTERED.

RE: Residency

I would like to emphasize a point to all managers regarding your basketball rosters. As the manager, you are responsible to verify that all addresses turned in are correct. If a player does not live at a Green Bay address within the city limits, they must pay our non-resident fee before they play in any games. Many postal addresses or driver's licenses indicate Green Bay, which include Allouez, Bellevue, Howard, Ashwaubenon, etc., but that does not mean they live in the Green Bay city limits. Therefore, please make sure the fees received by us are correct. If it is found that a residency is incorrect or has been falsified, all games in which that player has participated up to that point will be recorded as FORFEITS.

**Team players or managers must notify our department if they move out of the city limits during the course of the season, and appropriate fees must also be paid.

If you would like to double check your roster addresses before the season starts, I encourage you to do so by clicking this link: <https://prod-landrecords.browncountywi.gov/GCSWebPortal/Search.aspx>. Once you're on their website click on the I Accept terms button, at the next screen enter the player's address into the Property Address section then click the Search For Properties button.
